Subject contents	The history of modern universal and Polish art. The programme content covers issues that enable the student to learn and understand selected artistic issues. Knowledge is conveyed problematically. Art in Poland will each time be considered as a part of the European heritage, complemented by an analysis of specific manifestations of Old Polish artistic culture. The main emphasis will be placed on shaping the ability to formulate statements and hypotheses taken from the literature on the subject based on practising the skills of independent searching for sources, literature on the subject and its critical reading.
