Subject objectives	The objective of the course is to familiarize students with the mechanisms for protecting individual rights in enforcement proceedings conducted by public administration authorities. Students will learn the principles, legal and procedural measures that ensure respect for the rights of the debtor, as well as tools for controlling the legality and fairness of enforcement actions. The course aims to develop the ability to identify and solve legal issues related to the protection of individual rights in the context of administrative enforcement.

Subject contents	Celem zajęć jest analiza środków prawnych służących ochronie jednostki w toku postępowania egzekucyjnego prowadzonego przez organy administracji publicznej. W ramach przedmiotu omawiane są zarówno ogólne zasady ochrony praw jednostki w demokratycznym państwie prawnym, jak i konkretne instrumenty prawne takie jak środki zaskarżenia, kontrola sądowa, odpowiedzialność odszkodowawcza organów administracyjnych oraz standardy wynikające z orzecznictwa sądów krajowych i międzynarodowych (np. ETPC). Zajęcia mają na celu rozwinięcie u studentów umiejętności prawnej analizy sytuacji, w których egzekucja może naruszać prawa obywatelskie.
