Subject contents	The Kashubian lecture (a series of 10 lectures from October to December) concerns Kashubian issues in various fields of science: history, sociology, anthropology, ethnography, literary studies, linguistics, translation studies, musicology the main theme'25: Kashubians and Kashubian in the cultural landscape of Gdańsk. A unique feature of the lecture is the "changeable" person of the lecturer; the best Kashubians in their fields are asked to give the lecture. The lecture broadens the knowledge about Kashubia (people and region) and Kashubian (culture and language), and in a special way shapes the identity of Pomeranians. Each lecture consists of two parts: 1) a recording (approx. 30 minutes, see YouTube) to be listened to by the student before 2) a meeting with the speaker (MS Teams, Monday 17.00-18.30), which opens a space for dialogue, which is very beneficial for the development of the interests and research predispositions of the listeners. Example issues/ example questions/ tasks being completed	The final grade consists of: active participation in the lecture (attendance and a question asked to the lecturer recorded in the meeting chat) and writing a TEST at the end, including a short stylistic statement (2 thousand characters). The necessary condition for obtaining a pass is attendance at at least 7 meetings. The subject of the test and stylistic statement concerns the subject of the lecture. The final grade consists of the attendance criterion (taking into account the exceptions described below) and the test assessment. Absence from the Monday meeting (a necessary condition for passing the lecture, see above) can be compensated for by an additional stylistic statement - on the topic / problem of the missed meeting - sent no later than two weeks after the date of absence (to the main lecturer's email). Framework assessment criteria: vdb - min. 9 meetings held + work assessment min. good+, db+/ db - 8 meetings held + work assessment min. good, dst+/ pass - 7 meetings held + work assessed positively.
