Subject objectives	The aim of the course is to familiarise students with the artistic heritage of former East Prussia, with particular emphasis on residential architecture in its historical and cultural context. The classes focus on analysing artistic phenomena in relation to the political and social transformations of the region, including the issue of difficult heritage and post-war transformations, adaptations and reinterpretations of monuments. An important component of the course is the development of students skills in independent analysis, interpretation and critical understanding of the functions and meanings of works of architecture and art in changing cultural contexts.
