Subject contents	The perception of the Teutonic Order in history, literature, and popular culture; the Order in the 13th century and the conquest of Prussia; directions of rural colonization and urbanization in the 13th14th centuries and ethnic relations; the structure of the Order, including offices and functions, and the administrative division of Prussia in the 13th15th centuries; castles as administrative and economic centers of the Orders estates; Teutonic convents in the monastic state in Prussia and their internal organization; settlement, including groups of rural population, the process of founding villages, and village typology; town foundations in the 13th15th centuries, municipal law and the Teutonic Order, the Culm (Chełmno) Law, Lübeck Law, trade, and the role of the Order; ecclesiastical organization in the state (bishopsrics and chapters), urban parishes, and the religious life of the Teutonic Knights; monasteries and religious orders in Prussia, their internal organization, and social significance; the educational system and the studies of Prussian inhabitants; literary production and historiography; the political history and military activity of the Teutonic Order up to the early 16th century; and sources for research on the rule of the Order, including documents, letters, account books, and cartularies.
