Subject contents	Introduction to the regulation of sport the concept of juridification of sport and the role of sports organisations in the regulatory process. Sports organisations as normative actors basic types of organisations, their functions and regulatory competences. Types of regulations issued by sports organisations statutes, regulations, disciplinary rules and codes of ethics; their relevance in sporting practice. Legal foundations of sports organisations regulatory powers statutory basis, the principle of autonomy and limitations arising from state law. Relations between public law and sports regulations coexistence, conflicts and the primacy of state law. Validity and effectiveness of sports regulations recognition, application and enforcement of norms within the national legal order. Limits of sports autonomy the principle of legality, the role of state authorities and constitutional constraints protecting individual rights. Internal dispute resolution in sports organisations basic mechanisms for resolving disputes and their relationship with state courts. Influence of international and European law on sports regulations international standards, EU law and the case-law of European courts. Practical issues in the application of sports regulations discussion of selected examples from the practice of national sports associations and international federations (case studies).
