During the practice, the student implements the didactic process (topics of lesson hours) in accordance with the curriculum approved for the given class and educational stage. During the practice of English, the student implements the content correlated with the curriculum of the subject of English Didactics, the topics of psychology and pedagogy classes, and resulting from participation in various forms of school work, including the organizational structure of the school, its material base and conditions of activity. Observation of various elements of the lesson (e.g., sequences of tasks, relations: teacher-students, organization of students' work in the lesson, issuance of instructions, directions and explanations, use of teaching materials and resources, correction of errors, student behavior). Organizing own classes and maintaining student motivation and discipline in lessons. Creating lesson outlines, planning and evaluating lessons. Language of instruction. Lesson plan, curriculum and other documents regulating the work of the school. Teaching productive and receptive skills. Teaching vocabulary, grammar. Construction of tests, elements of didactic measurement. Selection, evaluation and application of teaching materials. Techniques for interaction and authentic communication in lessons. Teaching different age groups. Grouping of students and control of lesson work. Methods of activating, stimulating thinking and independent acquisition of knowledge in the process of teaching and learning.</p>
