Currency market - instruments, features, functions, foreign currencies and currencies, exchange rates (BID, OFFER, indirect and direct quotations), factors affecting the exchange rate, currency position, currency transactions.4. Capital market - instruments (bonds, concepts related to bonds, settlement price, clean price), shares (types, shareholder rights, pre-emptive rights, rights to shares), WSE, quotations and stock exchange orders, Investment funds, investment certificates, units participation, depository receipts.5. Derivatives market - spot and futures transactions, exchange and OTC derivatives, functions of derivatives.</p>
