Confronting the acquired psychological and pedagogical knowledge with the reality of pedagogical reality in practical action and the formation of attitudes and personal qualities necessary for the work of a special educator. An important goal is the student's verification of his pedagogical and therapeutic interests and motivation to work with people with special needs educational needs. Acquisition, within a given specialty, of the ability to conduct classes appropriate to it.
