Speaking vs. writing (differences in conventions). 4. Phraseology - correct constructions, frequency of use and typical mistakes. 5. Syntactic correctness (word order, sentence patterns: structure of complex sentences, participial clauses, use of abbreviations and function words). 6. Word-formation correctness (proper names and common nouns). 7. Inflectional correctness. 8. Dictionaries: types and usefulness. 9. Language corpora and other tools for assessing correctness. 10. Language contact in the context of etiquette (how to speak with respect for the listener). 11. Words in the service of persuasion (meaning and evaluation in various forms of persuasive communication). 12. How to speak so that people listen - on the effectiveness of utterances.		
Prerequisites and co-requisites	Students should understand the importance of linguistic correctness in both formal and informal interactions and be familiar with the factors that shape them. They should also be aware of the existence of language norms and know the criteria for linguistic correctness.
