Basic concepts of transformational grammar: linguistic competence and performance, rules, surface and deep structure. Ethnography of speaking. Aspects of communicative competence. Speech acts. Theory of language activity. The neurophysiological basis of language. Linguistic universals and innate language abilities. Design features of language. Language and other cognitive functions. Psycholinguistic foundations of listening, speaking, writing and reading (a system of habits and skills).
